

Fares change on all Linkbus services

From 31 March 2019, fares will be increased across the Linkbus network to be comparable with commercial operators in the city.

This will mean a rise in the cost of single and day tickets, including park and ride services.

Robin Hood card holders will continue to receive a discount on the cash price. Concessionary fares will still be available.
